



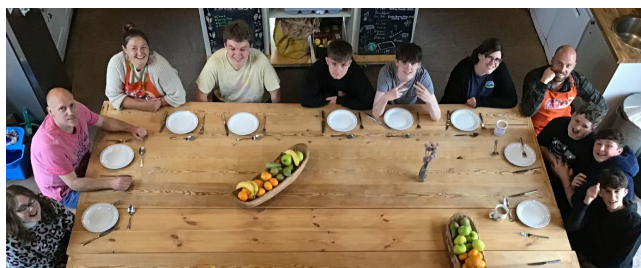

Well done to everyone that took part!



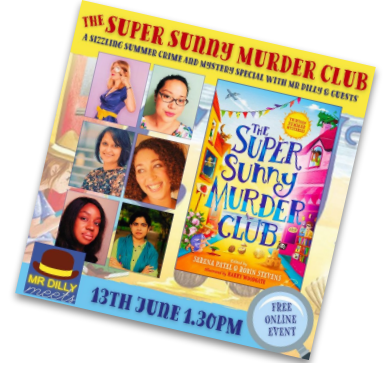


Ex-Site-ting updates
